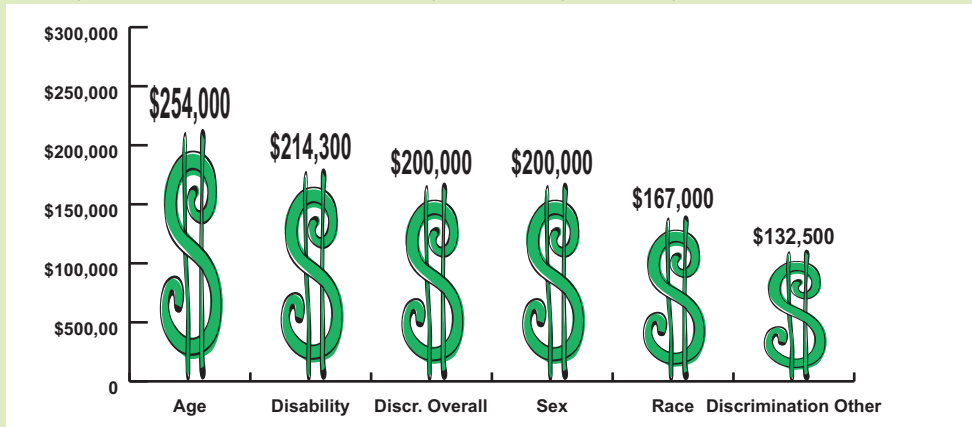


The Facts of Employment Law
